Teaching and Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carry out professional duties as required in the Conditions of Employment of School Teachers. Plan and teach lessons within the context of the school's plans, curriculum and schemes of work. Deliver lively imaginative lessons that encourage maximum participation and interaction of the children. Ensure high quality learning experiences for pupils, which meets internal and external quality standards. Assess, monitor and maintain records of children's progress in line with school policy and work closely with parents, giving feedback and sharing next steps in learning. To set high expectations for pupils' behaviour, fostering positive relationships and discipline among pupils by following the school's behaviour policy. Establish and maintain good relationships with children and all members of the school community. To provide a positive and safe learning environment. To support the schools SEND Policy on inclusion and to assist in the identification and teaching of children with special needs within the class. Direct and supervise support staff and resources delegated to them. Collaborate and work with colleagues and other relevant professionals within and beyond the school.
