

Lockerley Primary School is situated in a village on the edge of the beautiful Test Valley. The school retains some of the original Victorian buildings, along with more

modern extensions to create 4 full time classrooms, a music room, a well-stocked library, a multi-purpose hall, ELSA room and the latest addition to the building, the 'Monarch Room' used for small group work and the home of the Breakfast and After School clubs. The classrooms offer bright modern facilities with interactive whiteboards. All children have access to Chromebooks, laptops and iPads. There is a well-equipped playground, beautiful garden and a sports field. Our desire is to offer our children a rich and meaningful



learning experience that enable them to develop their self esteem and maximise their potential as young people.

Our school is set in a beautiful environment with surrounding woodlands and countryside. We have the benefit of outdoor teaching areas. The outdoors is a fantastic resource for our children to use. We strive to work in close partnership with our supportive parents.



We have close links with St John's Church in the village, and the Parish Vicar has an active part in the life of the school. The school uses the church frequently for special assemblies and celebrations. At our most recent SIAMS inspection in June 2025 the inspector reported "The Christian vision permeates through the daily experience of school life. The leaders of the school have created a calm, inclusive and nurturing environment in which pupils and adults flourish. Motivated by the vision of loving others, leaders prioritise

wellbeing. Their actions make sure that pupils and adults flourish within a happy community where they feel deeply valued as individuals."

At Lockerley Primary School, we offer a happy and friendly atmosphere where children can learn to become responsible and caring members of the community. The school has high academic standards. The children are happy to come to school and remember their time with us.

We currently have 79 children on roll. Children are educated in 4 classes, with pure Year R and combined age groups in Years, 1&2, 3&4 and 5&6. We strive to deliver a creative and well-planned continuous provision curriculum



up until Y3. The school provides a varied programme of extra-curriculum provision. We pride ourselves on the amount of and variety of after-school clubs available to all year groups. Currently our most popular clubs include singing club, running club and computing. The children love taking part in our cluster sporting competitions and events and enjoy the lead up to each competition with extra practise sessions.



Our children have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of educational visits relating to the work they are doing in class. We also have an active PTA who work hard to raise money for our school.

Our most recent initiative is running a community hub and inviting members of our local community to come and have lunch with the children.

We take great pride in the behaviour of our pupils and it is often praised by visitors to the school and when our children go on school trips. We have a Positive Behaviour Management Policy which is consistently applied by all adults who work in our school.
