Main Purpose of Role:	The post holder will take responsibility for a class of children in EYFS/ Key Stage 1 or 2 determined on an annual basis by the Headteacher and in accordance with the duties listed below. Applications from NQT's & SCITT's welcome.

General Responsibilities

- To interact on a professional level with all colleagues and establish and maintain good working relationships which will promote the development and effective delivery of the school curriculum and maximise children's achievement.
- Responsible for the supervision of the work of their teaching assistant and any students who may be on teaching practice or work placement in their classroom.
- Undertake the teaching of the pupils in his/her class and the associated pastoral and administrative duties in respect of those pupils as well as the general responsibilities in the school as agreed with the Headteacher.
- Teach all pupils in your class according to their educational needs and acknowledging that every lesson counts.
- Create a well ordered and secure environment that will ensure the educational well-being of individual children within the group.
- Make effective use of ICT to enhance learning and teaching.
- Undertake careful planning and delivery of the curriculum.
- Ensure careful and ongoing assessment of the pupils learning to inform further planning.
- Ensure that the curriculum is differentiated to mean that tasks and activities are matched to the ability of the children and henceforth allowing them to make progress at the right pace and level.
- Complete all assessments, reports and records as determined by school policy in a timely fashion.
- Work with school leaders to track the progress of individual children and intervene where pupils are not making progress.
- Work with school leaders to complete and teach individual pupil plans where pupils have specific needs. (EHCPs)
- Ensure that equal opportunities are implemented in the classroom and throughout the school.
- Develop and maintain positive relationship with parents, which involve them actively in the classroom and in the learning process.
- Participate in planning and staff meetings.
- Contribute to the whole school ethos by organising displays particularly in the classroom and designated whole school areas as agreed with the headteacher.
- Undertake in-service training for further development as a teacher.
- Undertake other duties, which may be reasonably assigned by the Headteacher to ensure the smooth running of the school.
- Contribute to the development, implementation and evaluation of the school's policies, practices and procedures in such a way as to support the school's values and vision

• Other Responsibilities

• In addition to undertake such duties of a similar nature as may be reasonably directed by the Headteacher from time to time. The duties and responsibilities of the post may vary from time to time according to the changing needs of the school.
