Lower Key Stage 2 Class Teacher (Part Time – 2 Days per Week)

Responsible to: Headteacher

Working closely with: Lower KS2 team colleagues, SENDCo, subject leaders

Purpose of the role

To provide high-quality teaching within a mixed Lower Key Stage 2 class, delivering engaging and inclusive learning that supports pupils' academic progress, independence and confidence as learners.

The successful candidate will contribute positively to the wider life of the school, working collaboratively with colleagues to provide a nurturing and ambitious learning environment where children are encouraged to thrive.

Key responsibilities

Teaching and learning

The class teacher will:

- plan and deliver high-quality learning across Lower Key Stage 2
- create an engaging and inclusive classroom environment that supports independence and curiosity
- deliver effective teaching that motivates and challenges pupils
- maintain high expectations for behaviour, presentation and engagement
- use assessment effectively to inform next steps in learning
- adapt teaching to meet the needs of all learners, including pupils with SEND and disadvantaged pupils
- support pupils to develop resilience, independence and positive attitudes towards learning

Assessment and pupil progress

The class teacher will:

- assess pupils' learning in line with school policy
- contribute to pupil progress discussions
- maintain accurate records of pupil progress
- use assessment information to identify strengths and areas for development

- support pupils to make strong progress from their starting points

Working with colleagues

The class teacher will:

- work collaboratively with phase team colleagues
- contribute to shared planning where appropriate
- work closely with support staff to ensure effective provision for all learners
- contribute positively to the wider life of the school
- communicate effectively with parents and colleagues

Safeguarding and inclusion

The class teacher will:

- safeguard and promote the welfare of pupils
- support inclusive classroom practice
- contribute to provision for pupils with SEND
- support disadvantaged pupils effectively
- follow school behaviour expectations: *Be Ready, Be Safe, Be Kind*

Wider professional responsibilities

The class teacher will:

- contribute to staff meetings and professional development
- maintain strong communication with parents
- support enrichment opportunities including outdoor learning
- contribute to the wider ethos and life of the school
- participate positively in school improvement priorities
