Key Responsibilities

Teaching and curriculum

• Plan and deliver lessons:

Develop and teach lessons across a range of subjects, adapting them to meet the needs of all students.

Set high expectations:

Create an engaging and challenging learning environment with clear expectations for behaviour and work.

Use varied methods:

Employ different teaching strategies, such as group work, demonstrations, and technology, to motivate pupils.

Assessment and progress

- **Assess student progress**: Mark assignments, assess student work, and provide feedback.
- **Track attainment**: Keep records and report on the academic progress and attainment of individual students.
- **Differentiate instruction**: Adjust teaching methods to support students with varying needs, including those with special educational needs.

Classroom and school management

- **Manage behaviour**: Establish and enforce classroom rules and routines to ensure a safe and respectful learning environment.
- Manage staff: Oversee the work of teaching assistants and other support staff.
- **Maintain the classroom**: Organize classroom layout, displays, and equipment.

Collaboration and communication

- **Communicate with parents**: Discuss student performance and behaviour with parents and guardians.
- **Collaborate with colleagues**: Work with other teachers and school staff on curriculum development and student support.
- **Liaise with professionals**: Cooperate with external professionals, such as education psychologists and social workers.

Professional and administrative duties

- Follow procedures: Adhere to school policies, particularly those related to safeguarding.
- **Complete administrative work**: Take attendance, manage records, and complete required paperwork.
- **Engage in professional development**: Participate in meetings and training to enhance professional skills.
- **Organize school activities**: Plan and supervise extracurricular activities, such as school trips and clubs.
