Reports to: The Senior Leadership Team (Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher and Assistant Headteacher)

General Duties and Responsibilities: To support and uphold the vision, mission and aims of our Catholic school.

Duties

- 1. Supervising the pupils whilst they eat their lunch and supporting the younger pupils eg encouraging them to finish their food.
- 2. Assisting pupils with cutting up food.
- 3. Aiding children opening cartons/pots of food.
- 4. Ensuring that the pupils sustain good table manners.
- 5. Cleaning spillages and surfaces.
- 6. Supervising disposal of foodstuffs whist encouraging pupils not to waste food.
- 7. Supervision of movement of pupils around the premises to ensure good behaviour.
- 8. Promotion of positive play ensuring productive lunch time activities for pupils.
- 9. Overseeing the clearing up of toys and equipment at the end of play.
- 10. Ensuring good hygiene washing of hands and toileting.
- 11. Basic first aid (grazes etc) and recording of accidents, maintaining appropriate records.
- 12. Reporting any significant behavioural incidents over the lunchtime period.
- 13. Ensuring confidentiality of incidents in school (ensuring children's behaviour is not discussed with parents outside the school).
- 14. Maintaining awareness of school, national and statutory policies and requirements and applying these in the work place.
