

Job Description

Professional Responsibilities

The postholder will be required to exercise their professional skills and judgement to carry out, in a collaborative manner, the professional duties set out below;

- To carry out the roles and responsibilities of a teacher as set out in the Teachers'
 Standards document.
- Plan, prepare, and deliver engaging and differentiated lessons in line with the National Curriculum for Key Stage 2.
- Foster a positive, supportive, and stimulating learning environment that encourages all pupils to achieve their potential.
- Monitor, assess, and report on pupil progress, adapting teaching strategies to meet the diverse needs of all learners.
- Lead, develop, and manage a designated subject area across the school, ensuring effective curriculum delivery, resource management, and staff support. (Non ECT)
- Work closely with the SENCO and wider staff to identify, plan for, and support pupils with Special Educational Needs, ensuring their inclusion and progress.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of Individual Education Plans (IEPs), provision maps, and differentiated strategies to support SEN pupils.
- Build positive relationships with parents, carers, and external agencies to support the holistic development of all pupils.
- Participate actively in professional development opportunities and contribute to the wider life of the school, including extra-curricular activities.
- Demonstrate high expectations of behaviour and learning, upholding the school's values and policies.
